

## NORTH AYRSHIRE OPEN ART EXHIBITION 2025

## **EXHIBITION RULES**

Artists are invited to submit 2 original artworks for selection.

An online application form must be completed. The application deadline is the 8th June.

Please bring your artwork to the 'Raquet Hall' at Eglinton Country Park, Kilwinning on Saturday the 28th June, between 10.30am and 3pm.

- The artwork must be the original work of the artist and the size for individual works is limited to 152cm x 152cm (5ft X 5ft).
- The maximum number of entries per applicant is two. There will be a charge of £10 for one entry, £20 for two entries.
- Entry fees should be paid in cash on Submission Day: Saturday 28th June.
- If you are submitting sculpture, please read the separate information sheet and follow the instructions for paying fees by bank transfer.
- Pictures must be framed suitably and securely. There must be D-rings attached, please see the 'Fixing Instructions' page for instructions.
- When you arrive on submissions day you must unwrap your artwork, pay your fee and we will attach a pre-made label to each artwork.
- Submitted artwork will be subject to a selection process. The selected work will be announced on our website <u>www.northayrshireopenart.com</u> on 3rd July.
- Unselected work will remain in safe storage until collection day on 20th July.
- The North Ayrshire Open Art Exhibition Committee will charge a **commission of 30% on all artwork sales**, this should be taken into account when pricing your work.
- All artwork must be collected from the 'Racquet Hall' between 12pm and 3pm on Sunday 20th July. No alternative date or time can be arranged.
- Unfortunately, we cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage to the artwork so it's important to arrange your own insurance.
